HOW TO APPLY

Applications

Go to www.lowaCollegeAid.gov/lowaNationalGuard

- ► INGSS requires 2 applications: FAFSA and IFAA
- Complete and submit your FAFSA until you receive an email from the Department of Education confirming application was submitted successfully.
- Complete and submit your IFAA until you receive an email from Iowa College Aid confirming application was submitted successfully.

Deadlines

Both applications need to be successfully submitted by the following dates.

- ▶ 1 July: For the upcoming Fall and Spring semesters
- ▶ 1 December: For the upcoming Spring semester only

Automatic Late Application Exceptions

- Were you on Title 10 Federal Active Duty orders over either the 1 July or 1 December deadline i.e. MOB / IADT?
- If so, you have 30-days from completion of those Title 10 orders to submit both applications.
- If not, and you submit the applications after the deadline, you and your unit need to submit a late application Exception to Policy (ETP) packet.

INGSS Determination

For applications submitted by the 1 July deadline

- ▶ Fall semester eligibility review will be the first few weeks of July.
 - Email notifications will be sent to the email on the application, from Iowa College Aid, in mid-July.
- Spring semester eligibility review will be the first few weeks of December.
 - Email notifications will be sent to the email on the application, from Iowa College Aid, in mid-December.
- For applications submitted 2 July 1 December
 - Spring semester eligibility review will be the first few weeks of December.
 - Email notifications will be sent to the email on the application, from Iowa College Aid, in mid-December.

The determination email will state approval or disapproval. If disapproval, the email will state the reason(s) of the disapproval.
