Moravia Community Schools, in accordance with Iowa Department of Public Health guidance, is currently not conducting contact tracing within the schools in the event of a positive case of COVID-19. The school will work closely with public health if deemed necessary for disease investigation.

CDC and IDPH recommend monitoring for the development of symptoms through 14 days after exposure and encourage an immediate 10 day isolation from the start of symptoms if they arise, as well as to consider testing for COVID-19. Please contact your provider if symptoms (listed below) develop after a known exposure.

Please continue to monitor your family DAILY for signs & symptoms of COVID-19:

***If your child is experiencing one of the high-risk symptoms (in bold above) OR 2 or more		

low-risk symptoms, please consult with your health care provider for recommendations.\*\*\*

We also want to encourage quarantine for family members with a positive case in the house. If families choose not to quarantine, then we highly recommend student(s) wear masks while at school regardless of vaccination status during the quarantine period.

o If a student has a known exposure and develops symptoms they will need a negative Covid test **OR** stay home for 10 days from the start of symptoms

IDPH is not requiring your student to quarantine after an exposure, but if you choose to quarantine your student, please let the school office know. CDC continues to recommend quarantining for 14 days after the last exposure.

Students are welcome to wear masks if they so choose at any time. We appreciate your assistance in keeping our school community as healthy as possible.
